

ZETES



The ZETES, a small high-class craft, is an open sailing-yacht of glass-reinforced polyester. Stable and fast with a swinging mast resting on a ball construction.

The ZETES can be supplied both with a fixed ballast keel and with a centre board. As a keel-yacht the ZETES is a fast, roomy and stable touring sailer.

As a centre board yacht she offers more possibilities in point of mobility, sailing in shallow waters and launching in places without cranes.

Floatation tanks make the ZETES unsinkable.

The rudder is of the suspension type and can be lifted. Taking everything together, the ZETES is a ready, strong and sturdy yacht.

Length 15', width 5.6'', draught 2.6'' with keel fixed. Draught centre board (aluminium) 9''-3'6''.

Dacron mainsail 92 sq.ft., jib 43 sq.ft. and, if desired a genoa of 70 sq.ft. The weight of the ZETES with centre board is 385 Lbs. and with keel fixed 605 Lbs.
